### **Protecting AE2**

- Protective Barrier against fishing nets and anchor cables
- Secure access hatch prevent illicit entry
- Marker buoy alert shipping to the presence of the submarine
- Alert Zone around the submarine no fishing or anchoring
- Monitored by Turkish Straits Vessel Traffic System

## **Preserving AE2**

- Cathodic Protection system arresting and reversing corrosion of the hull
- An enduring Gallipoli artefact and symbol -Australia's first ship lost in battle

- Feasibility Study completed 2006
- Joint Project Turkish Institute of Nautical Archaeology and AE2CF
- Assessment Phase dived expedition to gather data September 2007
- Joint Turkish/Australian Workshop Istanbul April 2008 recommended way ahead
- Australian Government endorsed AE2CF to develop plans for Implementation Phase to deliver recommendations


#### **Next Steps**

- Turkish and Australian Government agreement to Implementation Plan
- Proposed afloat expedition May 2012:
- Install protection and preservation measures.
- Complete internal archaeological assessment.
- Update documentary for educational purposes
- Proposed afloat expedition May 2014:
- Check survey of measures installed 2012.
- Recover any mutually agreed artefacts for further archaeological analysis
- Education Programme 3 phases completed in 2015
- 2015 The centennial of Gallipoli


